

INDIGENOUS LEADERSHIP OPPORTUNITY YEAR (ILOY)

APPLICANT PACKAGE AND CANDIDATE QUESTIONNAIRE

PART I

INFORMATION AND GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. This package consists of three parts. Part I provides information and instructions about applying to the ILOY program. Part II is a questionnaire to be completed by applicant and Part III is the Indigenous Self-Declaration Form. **These are not Canadian Armed Forces (CAF) enrolment forms.** Read the entire information portion carefully prior to completing the questionnaire. If you do not understand a response section, contact a Military Career Counsellor at your recruiting centre for assistance.
2. Type your responses into the form, or print your responses clearly and legibly in ink. (Do **not** use a pencil). Ensure you answer all sections applicable to yourself.
3. If you are selected in the ILOY competition, you will receive a conditional offer to attend the Royal Military College of Canada (RMC) to complete the one academic year program.
4. Under the terms of the ILOY program you will be enrolled in the CAF as a Regular Force (Reg F) member and will receive full subsidization at the RMC. You will receive a salary and will have rations and quarters deducted from your pay. There are no tuition costs and all mandatory books will be provided.
5. After ILOY, if desired and upon meeting the academic requirements, you have an opportunity to apply for admission to RMC to continue in a degree program or return to your community without penalty.
6. You may voluntarily release from the program at any time during the year.

SECTION A – EDUCATION LEVEL

7. As an ILOY applicant you will have completed, at a minimum, Secondary V, or Grade 12, or GED, by the end of the current academic year in which you are applying to ILOY.

SECTION B – APPLICANTS CURRENTLY ATTENDING CIVILIAN UNIVERSITY OR COMMUNITY COLLEGE

8. This section applies only to applicants who are or have been undergraduate students attending a civilian university or Community College who have not completed an Academic Bachelor's Degree and/or College Diploma.

SECTION C – ACADEMIC HISTORY

9. To assist the Selection Committee in determining your academic suitability for entry into the competition, you are required to provide the Recruiting Centre with official transcripts of your academic results of your High School, CEGEP, or GED Program (all programs attended). Complete this section carefully. A false declaration or omission may constitute a reason to reject your application.

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- a. Start with your current or most recent academic year of high school, college or university. If you are not presently in school, college, or university, indicate the year of the last course(s) you have attempted and/or completed;
- b. List **all** the subjects you are taking (Table 1) or will be taking (Table 2) during this academic year. Ensure you use a full descriptive title of your courses (e.g. Functions and Relations, Honours Algebra, etc.). Indicate the local coding of the course (e.g. MCA551, etc.) in the appropriate column;
- c. Enter the marks (preferably as a % grade) of each course reported to you by your school, taking care to be accurate;
- d. If you cannot enter a letter or % grade beside a course, explain why (use I for 'incomplete', W for 'withdrew', F for 'failed'); and
- e. Complete Table 3 with regard to courses repeated.

10. Students attending academic institutions in foreign countries must provide the Recruiting Centre with a copy of the course outline for each subject. This information is normally available from the institution or local board responsible for education. This is a mandatory requirement.

SECTION D – EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

11. Complete this section to include all extracurricular activities (employment, sports, physical fitness activities, volunteer work, community involvement, et cetera). Please provide as much detail as possible.

SECTION E – MISCELLANEOUS INFORMATION

12. As an ILOY candidate attending RMC, you may receive instruction in your choice of either French or English, during the academic year. You are asked to indicate your present linguistic ability in the English and French languages and to indicate which of the Official Languages you choose to receive instruction in. In addition, please provide your linguistic ability in your Indigenous language, if applicable.

SECTION F – ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

13. The Admissions Committee is seeking additional information in order to evaluate your application for admission to the ILOY Program. A personal statement is a way for us to get to know you a little better and to help us understand your transcripts.

14. In one (1) or two (2) paragraphs up to a maximum of one (1)page, please write a personal statement and tell us a little more about yourself. We would like to learn who you are, why you want to attend the ILOY program this year, and what you are wishing to achieve by attending the ILOY program.

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CONCLUSION

15. All offers for ILOY and continued subsidization are conditional upon the following:

- a. That you successfully complete the recruiting process prior to enrolment;
- b. That you maintain satisfactory academic results during the current academic year and graduate from high school. If attending a post-secondary institution, you must maintain satisfactory academic results for your current academic program. Canadian Forces Recruiting Group Headquarters reserves the right to determine what constitutes 'Satisfactory' academic results; and
- c. That you self-declare as being Indigenous.

16. Other conditions as determined by Canadian Armed Forces requirements may also be stipulated if an offer is made to you.

17. When you have completed the questionnaire portion, detach it from the information portion and submit it to your Recruiting Centre. Applications are to be submitted no later than 15 Feb. The sooner you complete and submit your questionnaire, the sooner your processing can be initiated. **GOOD LUCK!**

In short, please tell us about you, why you hope to attend ILOY at RMC, and what you hope to achieve in your time here. We look forward to reviewing your application, and we appreciate the time and energy you will put into preparing this personal statement.
